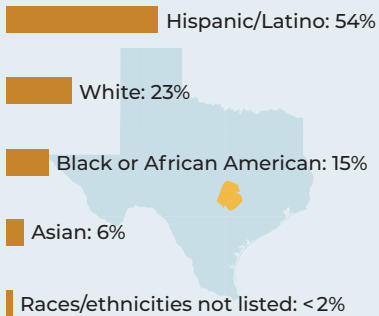

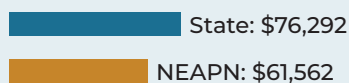

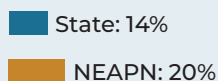
Community Composition

The Northeast Austin Promise Neighborhood (NEAPN) is a place-based initiative led by Austin Voices for Education and Youth to expand educational and economic opportunity. NEAPN builds on strong partnerships and a proven model of community schools and wraparound supports to drive systemic change. NEAPN uses an asset-based community development model, drawing on local strengths and trusted relationships to design solutions with families, ensuring accessible, sustainable supports across education, health, and workforce systems.



Early Childhood Education

Less than 30% of eligible children attend school-based prekindergarten.

NEAPN will offer free half-day prekindergarten for 3-year-olds at target schools to expand access.



K-12 Education

25% is the average student mobility rate due to housing and family needs.

Family resource centers will promote family stability, helping students stay in school.



College and Career Readiness

Only 22% of NEAPN residents hold a bachelor's degree or higher.

The Early College Program will help students graduate with a degree or college credit.



Family and Community Supports

26% of NEAPN families lack access to consistent healthcare.

NEAPN will connect families to care via clinics, promotoras, and school-based referrals.
